#### Art. 1.1 Preamble

This Supplementary Regulation shall be based on the FIA International Sporting Code including appendices, the DMSB Rally Regulations with the technical regulations, the DMSB Event Regulations, the DMSB Licensing Regulations, the General and Special DMSB Award Regulations, each in their respective valid version, the DMSB Environmental Guidelines, the WADA/NADA Doping Regulations and the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations as well as the Sporting and Technical Series Regulations (if applicable), the FIA Code of Ethics and Code of Conduct and the DMSB Code of Ethics as well as the other regulations of the FIA and the DMSB. Furthermore, the StVO and StVZO Regulations of the Federal Republic of Germany shall also be regarded. As far as there are no other Regulations announced within this tender, each and all of the above mentioned regulations are valid.

Modifications, amendments or additions will be published in numbered and dated bulletins. In any case of doubt, the German version of this supplementary regulation is binding.



- to crews whose entry has been refused.

The organiser may refund a portion of the entry fee paid by competitors who cannot start due to force majeure.

If the event cannot take place due to an official order, the organiser will refund the entry fee to the participants on a pro rata basis of 95 %.

During reconnaissance, compliance with the German Road Traffic Regulations (StVO) as well as the regulations of the road traffic authorities, including but not limited to speed limits, shall be mandatory. Please note that the Special Stages will not be closed to public traffic during the official reconnaissance. Therefore, the presence of traffic must be expected at any time. The organizer may reduce the allowed speed individually by marking the areas in the road book and along the route. Compliance with this regulation can be checked.

To ensure safety and uninterrupted service, the tracking system requires a continuous power connection with 9 to 28 volts DC. It is essential that the connection is NOT SWITCHED TO THE BATTERY'S PLUS POLE (DURABLE PLUS). Furthermore, it is essential to ensure that the tracking unit is always supplied with power. The power supply must not be switched via the ignition.

The competitors will receive the tracking unit and the fitting kit (rented) for the competition vehicle at the RallySafe transporter in the service area (see programme in chronological order (RA. Art. 3)).

The entire tracking system must be functionally installed in the competition vehicle before the respective technical scrutineering and checked by members of RallySafe Nederland at the RallySafe transporter in the service area.

Vehicles for which the tracking system could not be inspected, which do not pass a technical inspection and / or whose tracking system is not properly installed will not be allowed to participate in the shakedown / event. In this case the respective entry fee will not be refunded!

The system must be functional during shakedown and sporting competition (i.e. during the entire event). The tracking unit must be returned immediately at the end of the competition.

No deposit is required for the tracking unit. All participants sign for the return of the tracking unit. If at the end of the event the tracking unit is not returned to the organiser / RallySafe Nederland on the same day, the competitor / crew will receive an invoice of 2.000,- EUR on the following Wednesday, which has to be paid immediately and without deductions!

Competitors / crews who (have to) end the event prematurely and cannot enter the Parc Fermé must hand in the technology of the RallySafe tracking system (brackets, unit, antenna, etc.) IMMEDIATELY in the service area (ADAC truck / RallySafe transporter).

Competitors / crews who finish the event regularly and enter the Parc Fermé must remove and return the technology of the tracking system RallySafe independently BEFORE entering the Parc Fermé (TC EC-14).

The tracking system or the RS-Lite app must be permanently switched on during the reconnaissance, during the shakedown and during the competition (with the exception of the parc fermé). An inactive system will result in a fine of 100 €, pronounced by the clerk of the course. Further violations will be reported to the stewards for further punishment.

A team that has retired in the course of a stage is considered to have restarted from the start of the section following an overnight break. Otherwise, the form included in the back of the road book (deregistration certificate) must be filled in and handed over to the organiser before the publication of the restart list.

The competitor must inform the organiser in writing of the reason for the withdrawal (e.g. accident, technical problem, etc.) and the intention for a technical re-examination.

Only commercial fuels (definition see DMSB handbook, blue part) (DIN EN 228) according to Article 252-9 in Appendix J to the ISG with max. 103 octane (DMSB handbook, orange part, p. 14f), FIA fuel which must comply with the limit values in Article 252-9 in Appendix J to the ISG as well as diesel fuels (DIN EN 590) according to Article 252-9 in Appendix J to the ISG may be used.

FIA fuel in accordance with Article 252-9 in Appendix J to the ISG is only permitted if it is listed on the DMSB Approval List published by the DMSB office (available at www.dmsb.de).

In addition, fuels from the public filling stations listed in the invitation to tender/road book can be filled into the tank. In general, a maximum RON value of 103.0 octane applies to fuels - except for FIA fuels according to the DMSB approval list. Any additives, with the exception of air or lubricating oil for 2-stroke engines, are prohibited.

The use of bioethanol is not permitted in the DRM (cf. also General DMSB Regulations on Bioethanol E 85, Art. 3.5.2 in the DMSB Handbook, blue part, p. 6).

#### Art. 11.8 Changes to the entry form

Before presenting themselves for scrutineering, competitors may replace the car they entered with another car from the same division.

#### Art. 11.9 Special Stages – leaving the track
